Cookie Policy

These Cookie guidelines set out the basis on which State Bank of India (“SBI”, “us”, “we” or “our”) uses cookies and similar technologies in relation to its website /applications etc. These Cookie guidelines explain how and why cookies may be stored and accessed from your device while using or visiting our website/s.

By using our websites, you agree that we can place cookies on your device. Please be aware that some / all of our services may not function if your browser or device does not accept our cookies.

What are cookies?

A cookie is a small text/data file placed by a website server on user’s web browser, processor memory or hard drive of the computer/mobile device, when user visits a website. A “cookie” assigns the user a unique identifier that is stored on the user’s device. The Customer/user’s browser then provides the unique identifier each time they submit a query to the website. **First party cookies** are cookies set by the website you’re visiting. In addition, a website might use external services, which also set their own cookies, known as **Third-party cookies**.

Usage of Cookies

Bank uses Cookies to identify user’s interests, improving user’s website experience, storing their preferences, login information and to track usage of our websites. They are also used to control access to certain content on our websites, protect the websites, and to process any requests, to administer our websites and for research purposes.

What information as Anonymous user is collected

We gather and make use of anonymous information like the name of the Internet provider and browser / client details. We also perform web traffic analysis. This is collected / performed for maintaining information security of our environment.
